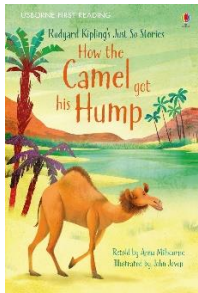
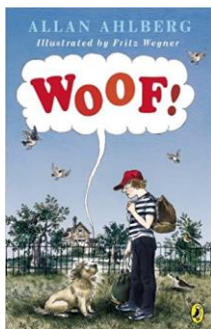


This is a list of suggested books for the children in Chestnut class to try to read. They are a mixture of classic texts and more modern writing that the children think they may enjoy.

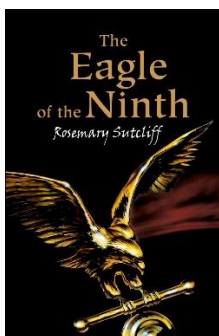
