### **Purpose of the Role:**

To work effectively as part of the Nursery team, providing a stimulating and caring environment for pre-school children.

### **Key tasks:**

1. Help prepare and participate in a range of activities that promote each child's physical, intellectual and emotional needs to enable each child to reach their full potential.
2. Assist the Nursery Practitioners with activities to encourage speech and language and social interaction between the children and their carers.
3. Work with a key group of children under the supervision of the Nursery Supervisor, observing, monitoring and recording each individual's development.
4. Attend parents evenings/open days as required.
5. Promote the philosophy of 'learning through play'.
6. Support children in acquiring self-help skills including dressing, feeding, toilet training and an awareness of personal hygiene.
7. Attend staff and team meetings as appropriate.
8. Help ensure that the Nursery meets safety and hygiene requirements and to report any issues to a senior member of staff.
9. Be aware of and comply with the Nursery's Child Protection Policy, Confidentiality Procedures and other Nursery Policies.
10. Keep up to date with developments in childcare through regular training as appropriate.
11. Work under supervision to maintain records and documentation that comply with statutory requirements.

12. Ensure that everyone is treated as individuals with respect and full consideration, in line with the Nursery Equal Opportunities Policy.
